**How to update to iOS 6**

## Prepare for iOS 6

While the iOS 6 update process is simple, and most likely no data will be lost, you should read the next few steps to make sure your iPad is ready.

- (1) Is there anything currently on your iPad that you created (document, pics, presentations, etc.) that is extremely critical and isn't somewhere else? If so, **back it up!** Click [here](#) or go to <http://goo.gl/tkSyA>
- (2) Now that you backed-up your iPad's critical information, be sure the iPad is either connected to the charger or has a lot of charge left. Do NOT interrupt the update process! This will possibly cause you to lose all. I suggest you update on solid home wireless if possible.
- (3) Since that's done, the update to iOS 6 is a breeze.

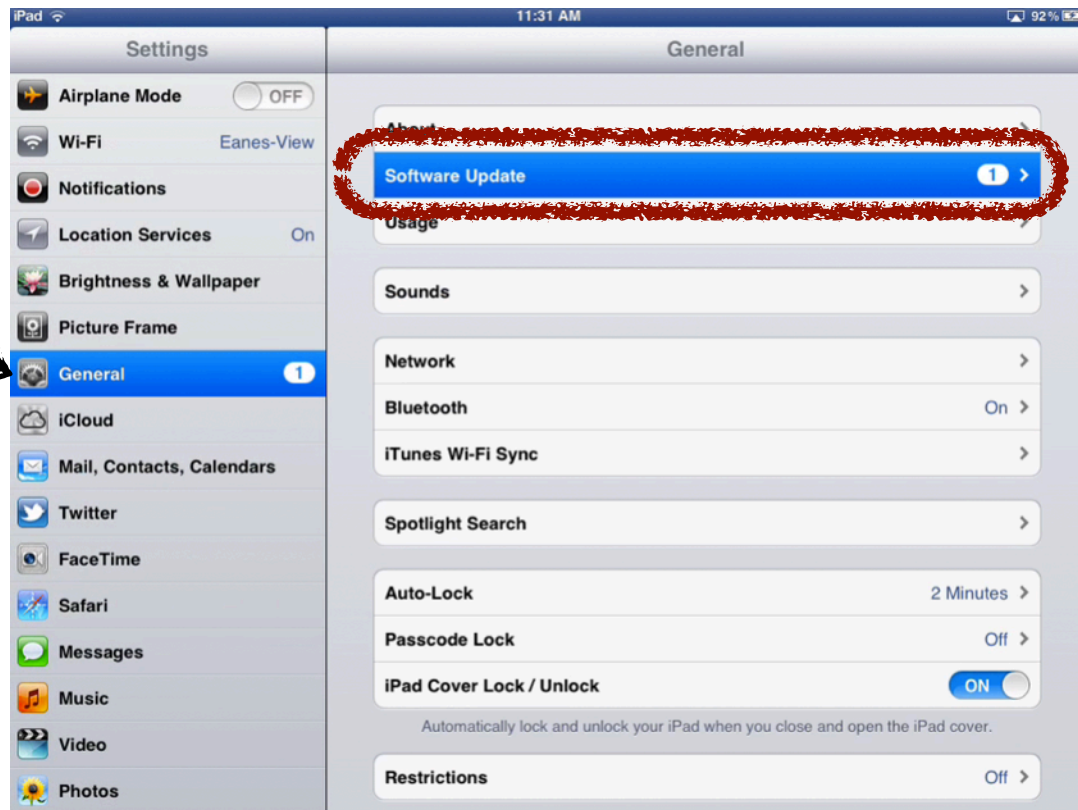
## How to Update to iOS 6

Users upgrading from iOS 5 will be able to upgrade Over-the-Air, or without plugging in to a computer. Follow the directions below to update to iOS 6. We recommend connecting to WiFi and doing this with a full battery or iPad connected to charger. You **cannot** use the iPad while it is updating.
